General Price List (Effective June 15, 2021)

The prices contained herein are effective **June 15, 2021** and are subject to change without notice. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to those who call upon us for care. You may choose only the items you desire. Any funeral arrangements you select will include a Basic Service Charge, which covers service and overhead. If legal or other requirements make it necessary for you to purchase items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement of goods and services we provide detailing all you have selected.

I. PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

Our fee for the services of the licensed funeral director and our staff includes, but is not limited to: Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 a year to respond to initial request for services; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics, preparation and placement of obituary notices, planning and coordinating all details of the committal with third parties i.e. cemetery, church etc. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as professional fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, maintenance, administrative cost, funeral equipment and furnishings and governmental compliances.

This fee for our Basic Service and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (It is already included in our charge for direct cremation, immediate burial or forwarding or receiving remains.)

VII. Forwarding remains to another funeral home \$3,500	

Our charge for this service includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home, embalming, and casket coach (hearse) for transportation to airport. This charge does not include viewing, ceremony or airline shipping charges.

International Paperwork Fee (does not include consulate, translation fees or other direct costs) **\$450**

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$3,100

Our charge for this service includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to the funeral home, and casket coach (hearse) for local transportation to local cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include visitation, rites, ceremonies, outside or cash advance charges.

VII. DIRECT CREMATION (From \$3,620 to \$3,870)

Our charge for direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies include, basic services of funeral director and staffs, local transfer of remains to funeral home, care of remains, and crematory fee. State and local laws do not require a casket for cremation. *If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternate container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of cardboard.*

Direct Cremation completed at our convenience and with no service or attendance and does not include outside charges such as but not limited to; crematory charges, death certificates and/or Medical Examiner permits, and removal of pacemaker.

IMMEDIATE BURIALS (\$3,500 to \$5,050)

Our charge for an immediate burial without any attendant rites or ceremonies include basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home, hearse (vehicle) for transportation to place of disposition, care of remains and service/utility vehicle. Remains will be buried at the convenience of the cemetery, vault company and funeral home staff.

Immediate burial with container provided by purchaser **\$3,620**

Immediate burial with minimum casket provided by the funeral home **\$4,820**

Payment Policy

Our funeral home is a small business and like many others in our community, out of necessity, we operate on a cash basis, relying upon the families we serve for prompt payment. Therefore, payment is expected at time of arrangements and due prior to services rendered.

Payment Options

- > Payment with cash or check.
- > Payment with an approved Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. Payments must be made in the funeral home; credit card numbers are unable to be taken over the phone. If the family wishes to pay with a credit card online, a **convenience fee** will be assessed at 3.5% to the total.
- > Pre-paid funeral arrangements with Coxe & Graziano, subject to verification the policy is valid.
- > Assignment of proceeds of a verified Life Insurance Policy.
Our acceptance of this mode of payment is dependent on the cooperation of the beneficiary and the insurance company. The insurance policy must be given to the funeral director for verification. We must have the Insurance Company's complete cooperation in providing information to the beneficiary, amount of the death benefit available, outstanding loans information, cooperation to get claim forms in a timely manner, and their acceptance of our written assignment. The insurance company will send the balance of any insurance proceeds directly to the beneficiary after the insurance company pays the funeral bill in full, from the proceeds of the insurance policy. The purchaser must obtain a certified death certificate for each insurance policy.
